

PHYLLOXERA WORKSHOP

7-9 DECEMBER 2009

Phylloxera remains the most important pest or disease threat to South Australia's vineyards. Each year we conduct a workshop for grapegrowers, winery staff and viticultural advisers to give first hand experience on all aspects of phylloxera.

The workshop is run in partnership with the Phylloxera Research Team based at the Rutherglen Research Institute. Training is conducted mainly in the field at phylloxera-infested vineyards and wineries in northeast Victoria.

The workshop covers:

- Phylloxera biology and lifecycle
- Identification of symptoms
- Identification of insects and galls on vines
- Economic impact
- Disinfestation protocols
- Prevention strategies



Workshop costs

The workshop fee is \$577.50 (inc GST). The fee includes all course notes, single room accommodation, tuition, meals and travel (does not include airfares to Melbourne).
